Learn to Skate / Play and Girls' House: Sign Up Now

Registration for our programs is open, with practices November through mid-March. Watch your children learn to skate and play the great game of hockey in the warmest rink in Western Massachusetts.

- ❖ **Learn to Skate** (ages 4-8, Saturday afternoons, \$135): for beginner skaters to develop skating and basic hockey skills.
- ❖ **Learn to Play** (ages 6-8, co-ed and girls' programs, Saturday afternoons and Sunday mornings, \$340): develop hockey skills and concepts, 3v3 cross-ice games.
- ❖ **Girls' House Team** (ages 8+, one weeknight and Saturday afternoons, \$340): geared toward newer skaters. The focus is on fun with games and skill building.

(Note that there is an additional \$48 USA Hockey registration for ages 6 and up.)

The Amherst Hockey Association is a nonprofit, volunteer-run organization serving over 300 Hampshire valley families. It also fields co-ed and girls' travel teams to children ages 6 and up.
